Our practice and staff are keen to identify and provide support to carers within the community.

Are you a Carer?

A carer is anyone who cares, **unpaid**, for a friend or family member who, due to illness, disability, old age, a mental health problem or an addiction cannot cope without their support.

If you look after someone, you may be considered a carer.

What support and advice is available?

Amongst other things we can support you by:

- * Providing a carer's assessment to discuss what would make your life easier
- * Providing online and local information and advice
- * Helping you to access support groups, social events and emotional support
- * Making sure that you stay fit and healthy by attending reviews and providing services like free flu injections
- * Provide access to counselling services if you feel you would like to speak to someone about any difficulties you might be facing
- * Help you to access other forms of support

What to do?

Speak to one of the practice staff to make sure that we know you are a carer. We can then provide you with a short questionnaire to help us discover the ways in which we can best support you.

- Over 65
- Have a long term condition such as Asthma, Chronic Heart Disease, Diabetes , Chronic Kidney Disease, Stroke
- Pregnant
- A Carer

Did you know that you can order your prescriptions and book appointments online or by using a mobile phone app?

You can register for this service by asking at reception. You will require some proof of identification—for example a passport, driving licence or utility bill and then the receptionist will issue you with the a User name and Password.

The system is easy to log onto and simple to use and allows you to book selected appointments at any time of the day. It also provides the ease and convenience of being able to order your repeat prescriptions without having to drop a request slip in to the practice.
