NHS 70th Anniversary Celebrations



This has been an important and well celebrated milestone for our National Health Service, 70 years since it's establishment in 1948 in the post World War 2 years of a social change leading Labour Government. Some of you may well re-call the way health care was before, sometimes a lottery of having GPs and Doctors with social consciences concerning those who might be avoided healthcare due to poverty, and, and inability to meet medical care charges, or delay treatment until it would be too late for a good outcome. The formation of the NHS was a huge positive change. Locally on July 5th this year our NHS Clinical Commissioning Group held a celebration event of 70 years of the NHS at St Luke's Hospice Gardens and invited along many Patient Group members. Our Chair Marion Wilson was asked to cut the Birthday Cake. A concluding speech by one of the NHS Doctors from the CCG Board of Directors was moving and direct in the expression of commitment to the best health service perhaps worldwide, and quoted the passionate concerns for it's future by Aneurin Bevan the Health Minister at the time.

Staffing

Dr Fernie is unfortunately now on long-term sick leave and may not return as a GP at the Practice by her scheduled leaving date at the end of October 2018.

A new Receptionist, Sam, has started work at the Practice at the beginning of September, he replaced Jacqui who left at the end of August. There will soon be another new face at Reception after one of our staff had to unfortunately leave due to family reasons.

General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) and Prescriptions

We currently ask for the patient's name and address when they or their representative collect a prescription from the Practice Reception. In future, for an additional level of security, the patient's date of birth will also be requested. The prescription will not be released without this date. Patients will also be encouraged to have their prescriptions sent electronically direct to their nominated chemist to save them having to come into the surgery.

Flu Season

The Practice is now taking bookings for Flu vaccinations. The Practice has also for the first time sent out SMS text messages reminders about this to patients who have consented to receive text messages from the Practice.

Home Visit Service

BB Healthcare Solutions, the local healthcare service that provided an extra out of hours GP service, has now been commissioned by our Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) to run a pilot scheme whereby they provide a Home Visit service to patients. This means that patients who request a home visit will be visited by a clinician employed by BB Healthcare Solutions anytime up to 6pm in the evening.
