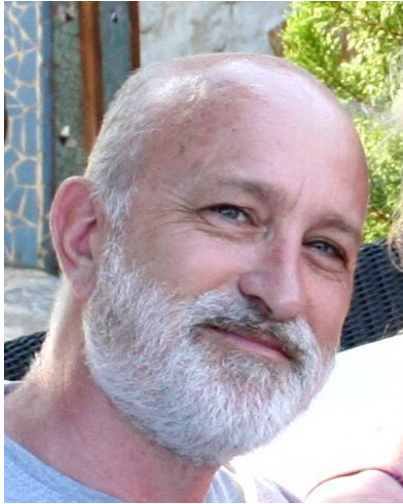


Profile of Dr Nick Turner
