

SHEFFIELD HOMES (SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL) REQUESTS FOR MEDICAL REPORTS

Guidance for Sheffield GPs

Agreement has been reached between the LMC and Sheffield Homes at Sheffield City Council that patients will not be asked to obtain medical evidence to support their rehousing applications.

Sheffield Homes rarely needs to obtain a medical report and, in circumstances where it is necessary, they will write directly to the GP enclosing the patient's written consent.

As this work is not part of a GP's contract of employment or terms and conditions of service and is not part of the NHS, GPs are entitled to charge a fee (fees are no longer set by the DDRB – the last DDRB set fee was £25.15 in 2005/06).

An invoice should be forwarded to Sheffield Homes with the medical report. It is not possible for Sheffield Homes to offer payment in advance.
