Marina Morgan is a Consultant Medical Microbiologist at Royal Devon & Exeter Hospital.

Special interest in exotoxin related sepsis, (toxic shock, necrotizing infections) and infections in pregnancy.

Topic

Still a major (and largely avoidable) cause of death, exotoxin related infections are often difficult to diagnose in the early stages. New versions of the old "killer bug" beloved of the media are emerging; but, be warned - the talk will include photographs of some severe infections, and illustrate pitfalls in diagnosis and controversies in management.
