

# Chesterfield GP Speciality Trainee Project Award



Open to any GP Speciality Trainee on the Chesterfield GP Training Programme

This includes ST1, ST2 and ST3 trainees

- The award is for original and innovative projects which will contribute directly or indirectly to the quality of patient care.
- Audit work should be undertaken whilst employed on the Chesterfield GP Speciality Training Programme & can be during GP or hospital attachments.
- Submissions should not normally exceed 3500 words and include a description of the project, innovation or audit which is being submitted.
- Submissions should be made before 30<sup>th</sup> June each year.
- Submissions can be made electronically or on paper and should be submitted to Margaret Attenborough.
- The extent of involvement of others must be stated on the submission.
- Submissions will be judged by Programme Directors of the Chesterfield GP Speciality Training Programme.
- The winner will receive £100 and be notified by 31<sup>st</sup> July.
