

**Integrated Training Post  
in General Practice/Ophthalmology  
at the West Cumbria Vocational Training Scheme**

A six-month post combining part-time General practice and part-time in the Ophthalmology under Mr W Sellar/Mr S Verghese at the West Cumberland Hospital.

Approximately 50% of the week is spent in General Practice and 50% is spent in Ophthalmology.

To work alongside the three consultants in the patterned suggested by them. To ensure their ophthalmology record of achievement is completed. To contribute to the service commitment expected in their training practice, have two hours of protected learning in the practice, the content of which will be learner needs led, after discussion with the GP Trainer.

There will be one hour's protected teaching each week within the department. The record of achievement will act as a baseline to define the curriculum. The needs of the learner will be considered in the educational programme. There will be two hours protected teaching in the GP component, supervised by the GP Trainer.
