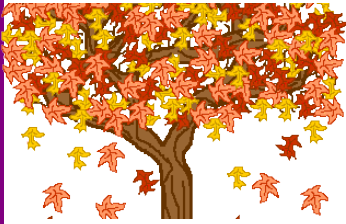

- Carers
- Patients with Learning Disabilities
- Children born between 1 September 2010 and 31 August 2013 (Nasal Spray)

Shingles Vaccines are also available to any patients who are 70, 78 or 79.
