



WELCOME TO CHAWTON HOUSE SURGERY

If you are moving into the area and living within our practice area, we will be pleased to register you here.

For registration we do require proof of your identity AND your address.

Suitable proof of identity is;

- passport
- driving licence photo id

Proof of address may be from;

- a driving licence
- utility bill
- rent book or something similar.

You will need to complete the GMS1 form in this pack – there are also notes to help you complete this. Bring the completed form with the proof of your identity and address (and medical history questionnaire) to reception and your registration will be completed.

You will be allocated a GP on registration. Continuity of care is a very important part of general practice so you will normally see the same GP at each visit. However this may not always be possible, due to availability of appointments, which is why you can see anyone in the practice. All clinicians have access to your clinical notes via the computer, but we do try to facilitate you seeing the doctor of your choice whenever possible. The copy of the practice booklet in this pack gives details of the doctors working in the practice, along with other useful information on our services and how to access them.

This pack also contains a Health Questionnaire – please complete this and bring it with you when you register. If you are registering any children under 16, they will also need to complete a special shortened medical history questionnaire. These details are important as it may be some time before we receive your full notes. The questionnaire **MUST BE** completed before registering.

If you are taking regular medication or have any other health issues, you will need to make a routine appointment to see a doctor.

Remember when you register, you must bring with you

- **a completed GMS 1 Form**
- **a completed Health Questionnaire**
- **your proof of Identity (as above) and address as above**
