Activities for children and young people with disabilities

Breaks from caring for parents and carers

There are a range of activities available in Swindon for children and young people with disabilities and their families. The Aiming High Short Breaks Team can work with families to identify the activities that would be most suitable for them.

This could range from:

- Information and advice about activities
- Specific activities for disabled children, including more specialist services
- Extra support to access activities, for example, a support worker

The extra support is to cover the **additional barriers** to enable the child to access the activity; it doesn't cover the cost of the activity itself. Extra support could be available for a wide range of activities, not just those run by Swindon Borough Council.

This was a small pot of money that providers could bid for in order to run additional activities for children and young people with disabilities in Swindon.

There was a very high demand for the funding, with lots of bids submitted. Parent / carer representatives were part of the panel that reviewed the applications and decided how the money should be used.

Have you got a SwindonCard?



The SwindonCard is an advantage card offering discounted prices at leisure facilities and other council venues in Swindon. There are three levels of discount depending on your circumstances, with extra savings on some activities at off-peak times.

Supporter card:

If the main applicant is in receipt of Incapacity Benefit, Disability Living Allowance, Employment and Support Allowance, War Disablement Pension or Attendance Allowance, an additional SwindonCard will be issued free to be used by one supporter when accompanying the applicant to the same activity. The supporter is entitled to a free activity price.

How to apply:

You need to complete an application form and take it along to any of the issuing sites, together with your payment, proof of identity and concessionary status. All applicants need to be present. Most Swindon Borough Council leisure centres can issue SwindonCards. Alternatively you can go to the Council's One Stop Shop at Wat Tyler House (entrance on Beckhampton Street).

STEAM Museum:

Free entry for carers

Did you know that the STEAM Museum offers free admission to carers or helpers assisting a visitor with disabilities?

Season Tickets are also available, offering unlimited visits for one year.

A Season Ticket for a concession is £15.95 (students, children and senior citizens).

Free parking is available for blue badge holders, just outside the building. When you reach the barrier, you just need to press the button and say that you have a blue badge.

The normal membership or admission fee applies for the disabled visitor.

To save having to 'request' a companion's free entry, you can get an 'Access for All Admit One Card'.

The card is in the name of the disabled person, so you are not restricted to taking the same person each time.

Bournstream play and picnic site for children with special needs

Wotton-Under-Edge

Bournstream is an adventure play site on the Cotswold edge, between Gloucester and Bristol, near Wotton-Under-Edge. The site is for children and young people with disabilities or special needs, their families, carers, respite groups and special schools. It is not open to the general public and it is dog free.

The site includes sandpits, climbing wall, play house, swings, roundabout, slides and football pitch. There is also a water play area, picnic areas and pathways for bikes, play vehicles and wheelchairs.

Bournstream is not staffed. It is run by volunteers and managed by a committee.

There is a one-off payment of £10 when you first come. Access is via a locked gate, and there is an on-site car park. The toilet facilities include a baby changing unit but *not* an adult bed or hoist.

The site opens from April until the end of November. (Outside of these times the water is turned off to stop the pipes bursting, and the toilet house is locked up.)
