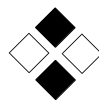

Named GP for Every Patient Under 75 Years of Age

By the end of June 2015 all patients (including children) will have been assigned a named, accountable GP. This will normally be your registered GP. The named GP will take lead responsibility for the coordination of all appropriate services required and ensure they are delivered to each of their patients where required.

You will still be able to see any GP at the practice and not only your named GP. We will be informing patients of their named GP during the year by various methods or you can contact the practice if you wish to know who your named GP is. If you have a preference for your named GP please let us know and we will make every effort to accommodate this request.

The pilot scheme is funded by Wiltshire CCG and will be reviewed to make sure patients are benefiting from the change.

Check In Screen

Did you use our check in screen when you arrived for your appointment today? Using the screen to tell us you have arrived for your appointment frees the receptionists to help patients with queries whether in person or on the telephone. This helps to keep the queues to a minimum. If you didn't use it today why not give it a try next time? It's very straightforward to use, just follow the onscreen instructions.

Hot Weather Advice

High temperatures can be dangerous, especially for the elderly, the very young and people with chronic or long-term medical conditions.

- Keep plenty of water to hand and stay in the shade whenever possible.
- Identify the coolest room in the house, so you can go there to keep cool.
- Try to avoid going outside between 11am and 3pm, as this is the hottest part of the day.
- Drink water or fruit juice regularly and avoid tea, coffee and alcohol.
- Cool the skin with a wet sponge or flannel.
- People with heart problems, breathing difficulties or serious illnesses may symptoms become worse in hot weather, so make sure you have enough medicines in stock and take extra care to keep cool.

Heat Exhaustion and Heatstroke

Heat exhaustion can happen to anyone in hot weather, and if it isn't treated can lead to heatstroke, which can be dangerous and even fatal. If you or anyone else feels unwell, drink water and go somewhere cool to rest. Don't leave babies, children or elderly people alone in a hot car.

If you suffer from hay fever your local chemist can supply most medications over the counter, both traditional and alternative. If you have prescribed medication each year please make sure you have some in date for use when you need it.

Repeat Prescriptions

If you are going away on holiday this summer please ensure you have sufficient medication to last the duration of your time away. Make sure you request any repeat medication requirements well in advance of your departure date.

Missed Appointments

Every missed appointment is precious clinical time wasted. As you can see from the statistics below, every month we suffer a high number of missed appointments. You may be surprised to learn that each month over 20 hours of clinical time is wasted due to patients failing to attend their booked appointments.
