There are morning and evening surgeries every weekday from Monday to Friday. Please telephone or visit the surgery between the hours of 8am and 6.30pm to make an appointment. Urgent cases will always be fitted in if the surgery is fully booked, please telephone the surgery and an allocated time will be given to you. This system enables us to plan our work and extend surgeries to meet demand.

We offer extended hours with a Practice Nurse on Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday morning from 7.00 - 8am and Friday 7.30am - 8am. If you would like one of these appointments please contact the surgery.

REDWOOD HOUSE PATIENT PARTICIPATION GROUP
