



OUR SERVICES

Rehabilitation & Re-Ablement Centre

Open 9.30-3.30 five days a week, the aim of the Rehabilitation Centre is to enable clients to reach their full potential by re-learning skills, such as kitchen, computers, woodwork and gardening; and engaging in a variety of therapies, including art, music and cognitive.

We will support clients to come to terms with their disability and to build confidence for the future.

Outreach Service

Outreach is a free service to help make initial contact with those who have suffered an ABI (Acquired Brain Injury) and their families. We provide information and support. We can act as advocate for those with an ABI and help link you with other services which may be helpful.

ABICS - Acquired **B**rain **I**njury **C**are and **S**upport.

This is our specialist domiciliary care and support service. Our aim is to enable and re-able our clients to improve quality of life and reduce dependency. We work with clients throughout the county.

We work alongside clients to build confidence and wellbeing. We cover personal care, take clients shopping, assist with cooking and budgets to maintain tenancy of their properties. We attend appointments with them. We aim to reduce care packages over a period of time where possible by re-enabling clients.

Cost per hour is dependent on assessment of client.
