Flu Vaccinations for patients over 65 years old and those in 'at risk' groups will be available at the surgery from the end of September. The flu clinics are scheduled to commence from Monday 22nd September. Flu vaccination appointments are available to book via Reception.

Shingles Vaccinations – patients with a birthdate between 2nd September 1934 and 1st September 1936 or between 2nd September 1943 and 1st September 1944 are now eligible to have a vaccination against Shingles. Patients who fit into the criteria and who would like to receive the vaccination are invited to contact Reception to book an appointment.

Voluntary Car Scheme – for those patients who reside in Staffordshire and don't have access to transport there is a voluntary car scheme available that can be used to bring them to the surgery.
