Relocation of the Practice to Dardsley House

- Delays on confirming the full costs of the refurbishment mean that work on site will not start until late summer. An target opening date cannot be confirmed until work commences
- Pharmacy not willing to commit at this stage

Doctor, Doctor Project and Dardsley Launch Event

- The application to the Heritage Lottery Fund to support collecting and celebrating community memories of health in Lostock Hall as part of NHS70 has been successful with an award of approximately £40,000. The project is called Doctor, Doctor!
- Practice staff and volunteers from the PPG will hand out leaflets from a stand at the Lostock Hall Carnival on Saturday 7th July to raise awareness of the project
- A launch event is planned for Saturday 21 July to provide a preview of the Dardsley site, appeal for memories and volunteers for the Doctor, Doctor! project and inform the community about health & wellbeing. A range of other health organisations and entertainers are being invited to participate. Some fundraising to occur for a new piece of health equipment. Locality Working including Care Homes Initiative

- Continuing to work closely with Ribble Bank Medical Group (RBMG) (practices in Penwortham, Longton and Kingsfold)
- Extended Care Home Service work for Coote Lane, Lostock Lodge, Chestnut Grove and Willowbrooke homes has now commenced
- GP Provider Company for Preston & Chorley being established to give Primary Care a unified voice in the health economy

- Improvement report accepted by CQC. CQC has now upgraded the rating for the practice to Good In All Areas
