PHARMACOTHERAPY - CARMEN AND LINDA





COMMUNITY LINKS PRACTITIONER- ARZOO






RESPIRATORY NURSE-ALISON



Alison our Respiratory Specialist Nurse, is here alternate Thursdays to review our respiratory patients. Her main focus is to review those who are potentially uncontrolled (e.g. overordering reliever inhalers or frequent courses of rescue antibiotics/steroids) and those on high doses of inhaled corticosteroids, and she also supports the Clinicians in reviewing our respiratory patients generally.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST- MOLLY

Molly our Occupational therapist comes into Practice on a Wednesday morning and can support our patients. She can help you to manage everyday activities that you are finding difficult.



CHILD IMMUNISATION NURSE-SUZANNE



Appointments are sent out by the Health Board for the routine infant immunisations and your child will be recalled automatically for any subsequent immunisations. Immunisations are given by our Immunisation Nurse Suzanne here at the Practice.

These clinics are held on alternate Thursday morning by appointment.

DIETCIAN- ELAINE

Our dietician Elaine runs a clinic monthly in the surgery for all aspects of dietary advice. She will see patients at home when necessary. All appointments are made by the dietician.

2023/2024 Autumn/Winter Vaccination Programme

This programme has started and people who are eligible will receive an appointment letter from the health board inviting them for their flu vaccine and covid boosters. If you cannot attend the appointment allocated on the letter. You can change this via the NHS Inform Booking portal or by calling the National Contact Centre on 0800 030 8013 Those who are eligible will also be invited for shingles and pneumococcal vaccines here at the practice.
