IMMUNISATIONS

Please note that payment is required on arrival at the reception desk for your immunisation appointment.

Please remember to seek our advice at least four months prior to travelling to allow for the full courses of vaccinations as appropriate.

A blood test to check hepatitis B immunity status is required one month after the third immunisation – the sample will be taken at the surgery by the nurse and charged as above. The test & result will be charged directly to the patient by the Nuffield Hospital, Plymouth.

Hepatitis B Vaccination

- Ø If Hepatitis B is required for travel purposes you will be charged as above.
- Ø If Hepatitis B is required for occupational purposes your employer will be charged as above and you will be issued with a certificate showing your immunity status. If your employer has an Occupational Health Department, immunisation should be offered through them. **We require written confirmation from the employer of their agreement to fund the course of immunisations.**
- Ø If Hepatitis B is required for education purposes (university student) the Occupational Health Department for the respective University is responsible for the students' immunity status screening and vaccination. If charges cannot be reimbursed the student is responsible for payment.
