Patient Survey

The group met to agree the priorities for our Patient Survey 2013/14 as per the action from our last meeting on 20th March 2013.

The practice has previously used CFEP however the group felt that this particular survey did not provide us with accurate and meaningful data to use for improving or enhancing the service we provide.

It was therefore agreed that we could concentrate on 3 main areas, plus a 'friends and family' test. We would also allow lots of opportunity to leave comments.

The 3 areas are:

- 1. About the appointment
- 2. About the practice
- 3. About the visit today

We intend to start this survey week beginning 25th November and run it for 2 months. This should give us a larger sample of patient views.



We will meet again in February to review the findings.

North Durham CCG Update

Details of the Winter Pressures scheme were discussed. The scheme has been introduced to try and reduce the demand on A&E and 111 during the busy winter months.
