3) The group discussed the recent data from our Online Booking of appointments and Ordering of repeat prescriptions activity. We discussed the benefits of the initiative to patients and staff. It was suggested that the number of online bookable appointments should be capped, however as the numbers per week were still only 25 on average(from approx 700) it was agreed that we would continue monitor this.

Sue gave an overview of the new NHS structure that is taking place on 1 April 2013. It showed the removal of SHA's and PCTs, and their replacements. We discussed the formation, commitment and authorisation of North Durham CCG, and their aim of providing "Better Health for the People of North Durham", highlighting the local membership of GP's and PM's from Derwentside. We talked about role of the patient being at the centre of all decisions.
