The 3C's

This is a health initiative aimed at young people where the surgery will offer advice on **C**hlamydia, **C**ontraception and **C**ondoms as part of a sexual health service. We can offer anonymous screening for chlamydia, the surgery can provide an array of contraceptive options and will supply a small number of free condoms for those patients holding a 3C's or C Card.

"We provide a confidential service to all our patients, including those under 16 years. This means that you can tell others about this visit but we won't. If you have any concerns about this, please feel free to ask a member of staff"

"CALLING ALL YOUNG PEOPLE!"

The practice will be holding a series of vaccination sessions (in the afternoons /after school) for all teenagers who need booster vaccines.

Those who are in need should receive a letter from us shortly - it is important that you make an appointment as soon as possible to ensure you long term protection is maintained.

You will be asked to complete a health questionnaire, which you should bring to your appointment. All information is confidential.

If you are over 16 years, thinking of travelling or going to University and think you may have missed out – please ask at reception we may still be able to help.

Data Sharing Electronic Records

Today electronic records are kept in all the places where you receive healthcare.

These places can usually only share information from your records by letter, email, phone or fax.

At times this can slow down your treatment and mean information is hard to access.

From November 19th our computer system will have the ability to share data with some of the other teams providing your care.

You can choose to share your record or you can choose not to, your doctor will ask you to let them know

what you want to do when you next see them.
