Appointments:

Appointments can be booked in advance - please contact the surgery to make an appointment. A normal appointment time is 10 minutes for one problem. If you require more time than this please ask the receptionist to allocate a longer appointment for you to allow the clinician enough to time to address all your needs.

If you arrive more than 10 minutes late you will be asked to re-book.

Home Visits:

Home visits will be triaged by the Doctor to assess suitability. To help the doctors please come to the surgery if you possibly can, where better facilities are available and the regular practice team can see you. Home visits are currently done by specific home visiting teams and not the regular GPs. At the surgery you will be seen quicker than waiting for a visit. Please telephone for a visit request BEFORE 10am or we may not be able to oblige with your request.
