CHUCS Service

The Care Homes nursing service provided by CNCS nurses (some of whom are prescribers, some training for this) provides support to specified care homes for the following indications:

- End of Life care including advance care planning
- Pro-active admissions avoidance care planning including reviews post discharge.
- Urgent same day need for assessment (to reduce pressure on GP surgeries).

Homes are encouraged to contact SPA directly to request input but GP practices can also signpost homes to contact the service for appropriate patients. Homes covered are attached.

On the brink: The Future of End of Life Care

Seven major leading cancer charities including McMillian Cancer Care and Marie Curie have jointly published On the brink: The future of end of life care. This report finds that too many people approaching death are forced to spend long periods of time in hospital due to a lack of social care or alternative support options in their community. This in turn leads to increased hospital admissions and higher costs for an NHS under financial pressures.
