Coordinated Care Register

FACT SHEET

It is often helpful to discuss the wishes and choices you would like to be considered as you become less well.

Making your choices known early can make decisions easier for your family/carers and those that care for you, should you no longer be able to express what you want to happen.

The Coordinated Care Register is held electronically by St. Luke's Hospice. It is held within our electronic patient record system.

The Coordinated Care Register is a way we can share your information with those people you may contact if you need assistance. Examples of people we share information with are your GP, Community Staff, OneResponse Service, East of England Ambulance Service and NHS 111.

You can decide not to have your information recorded on the care register, and even if you agree, you are always able to remove your information by informing your specialist or community nurse. This will in no way affect your on-going care.
