## A message from the Practice Nurses...



Providing advice and vaccinations for travel can be very time consuming if the travel plans are complicated.

We can only provide basic advice and a lot of travel vaccinations are

not kept in stock so need to be paid for in advance before we can order them in.

If your travel plans involve multiple countries or are for an extended period of time we would recommend a travel clinic that specialises in this area.

*Boots* in the Arndale centre has a travel clinic. You can book an appointment online and they can provide all the vaccinations, anti-malarial and travel health advice.

It is recommended that you make an appointment 6-8 weeks prior to travel in order to be fully covered.

The practice would like to alert all patients to the website launching this initiative. #### Pneumococcal Vaccination

The pneumococcal or pneumonia vaccine protect against pneumococcal infections such as pneumonia, septicaemia (a type of blood poisoning) and meningitis. Pneumococcal infection can affect anyone. However, some people need the pneumococcal vaccination because they are at higher risk of complications. These include:

- Adults aged 65 or over
- Children and adults with certain long-term health conditions, such as a serious heart or kidney condition.

People over 65 only need a single pneumococcal vaccination, which will protet for life. It is not given annually like the flu jab.

## **Urine Samples**

It is essential that all samples are clearly marked with your name and Date of Birth.

Unfortunately samples without legible name and date of birth will be rejected as we cannot guess which patient may have dropped off the sample. Regretfully we cannot accept samples left in any other container other than a white top pot.



## **Emergency Dentist**

If you require emergency dental treatment the telephone number is 01323 449170. In normal opening hours your Dentist should provide you with antibiotics for teeth or gum infections. Please do not ask your Doctor to do this.

# Text reminder service

The practice has just started to use a new SMS service to both confirm your appointment and to remind you within 24-hours of your booked appointment. The reminder service gives you the option to **CANCEL** your appointment by returning a text to your received message. Please use this option if you no longer need your appointment so

that we can offer it to someone else.

### Surgery Opening Hours

**Monday - Friday** 8.30am - 12.30pm 1pm - 6pm

Telephone access to our Reception Team is available continuously from 8.30am to 6.30pm.



Extended opening hours on Wednesday mornings from 7.30am and one night per week until 8pm (*please see below*).

We are here to help you so please call us first before considering the use of A & E. It is likely we will be able to see you much quicker and as we have all your medical details in front of us can ensure you get the best care in the quickest time. If you're not sure what to do please ring us first; we can offer advice to you on the telephone or organise a same day appointment if you need it.

We also offer extended opening hours as follows: GPs start morning surgery at 7.30am on Wednesday mornings and two GPs and one nurse offer late clinics on either Tuesday or Wednesday evenings on rotation. These are for routine pre-booked appointments only and are not intended as 'walk-in' or emergency sessions – only patients who have pre-booked their appointments will be seen.


