John Black – Psychotherapist & Hypnotherapist

John gave the meeting a very informative and entertaining presentation on the history and benefits of talking therapies with the emphasis on Hypnotherapy. He explained that there over 400 different types of talking therapy. John explained that peoples impression of the subject is based on false information and the most common fear is that the subject (Client/ Patient) will lose control. This is not true and hypnosis will only work if the subject wants it to. The Hypnosis he uses increases both the focus and imagination and concentrates on the sub conscious area of the mind. His approach can help with eg anxieties, stress, tinnitus, insomnia, some pain management and phobia's.
