### **Emergency Contraception**

### PEP (Post Exposure Prophylaxis) for HIV

- Post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) is a treatment that can reduce the risk of HIV infection after contact with the virus
- If you need PEP you can walk into any of the following CNWL Hub Clinics:
  - Buryfields Clinic, 61 Lawn Road, Guildford, GU2 4AX
  - Earnsdale Clinic, 2 Whitepost Hill, Redhill, RH1 6BD
- You can also get PEP by attending an Accident and Emergency Department

### **Sexual Assault**

- If you have been sexually assaulted you can visit a specialist centre for advice and to arrange a forensic examination
- CNWL does not offer forensic examinations but we can provide emergency contraception, PEP and sexual health screening and treatment
