Having healthy sex

You're the only person who will know when you're ready for sex, don't be pressurised into it. If you feel someone is pressurising you to do something you don't want to, come and talk to us.

If pregnancy is a main concern then you should make an appointment with us for some effective contraception. There are lots to choose from and one will be right for you.

Anyone who is sexually active can get a Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) you do not always know if you have an infection as they may not cause you any symptoms so it is important that you get checked. We recommend that you and your partner(s) have sexual health testing before having sex at the start of a new relationship.

Condoms

If you're ready then it's important that you think about how you might reduce any of the negative things that might happen. You can't really go wrong with using condoms. If used correctly every time then they are 98% effective at reducing the chances of pregnancy and limiting the spread of sexually transmitted infections (STIs).

Condoms are available for **free** via the C-Card scheme for under 25 year olds, ask at one of our clinics, or visit the healthy Surrey website for a list of outlets: www.healthysurrey.org.uk/your-health/sexual-health. You can also buy condoms from Boots and other chemists, but you might prefer to purchase them anonymously online, such as from Freedoms-Shop.com. Freedoms Shop is run by CNWL, the same organisation that provides all sexual health services in Surrey.

Free and confidential services

Anyone can use free NHS Sexual Health Services. In Surrey you can access services either by visiting a clinic or by ordering an online home screening kit. Either way you choose, the service will be completely free, confidential and non-judgemental.

Sexual health clinics

We have three main clinics in Surrey which are open extended hours most days; there are also a number of locations where we run clinics one day a week. If you live in Surrey you can now order a home screening kit from www.sexualhealth.cnwl.nhs.uk/surrey-kits

You'll be sent a pack which contains swabs and easy to understand instructions.
Simply send back the samples and we'll tell you your results.
Lots of people who are busy or do not live near a clinic choose to use this service as it gives you the time to do the things you'd rather be doing.

What to expect at your appointment

All of our services are confidential which means that we will not share your information or tell anyone about your visit or use of any of our services unless we believe that you, or someone else, are at risk of serious harm. If we believe this to be the case we may need to talk to other people outside of CNWL so that you can get additional support to protect you. We will always discuss this with you first before talking to anyone else.

We have four local clinics

Our smaller clinics provide contraception services including condoms.
