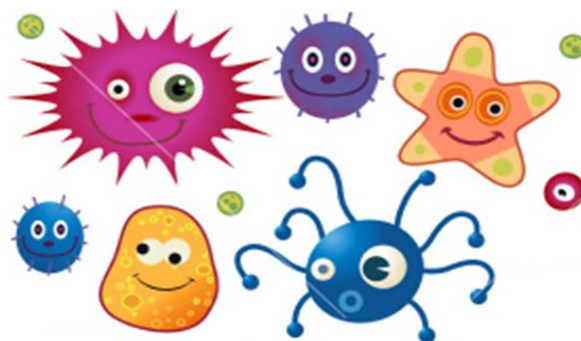


# ***Are you here with a child that has a chest infection?***

Did you know that many children do not actually need antibiotics to recover fully and in fact in some cases it may cause what we call antibiotic resistance – the increase in ‘superbugs’ which do not respond to antibiotics.

The doctor /nurse may ask you to help in a research project called ARTIC PC to help us work out which children do need to have antibiotics to help them recover. This has two parts one where you will take either antibiotics or a placebo (a dummy medicine) with optional tests or one where you have the treatment the doctor/nurse provides and you can take the tests. In both we will follow up how quickly the child gets well.
