We regularly have other learners in the practice as medical students from both London and Oxford spend attachments here and we have taken part in pilot posts for district nurse and nurse practitioner training and the whole practice is committed to learning.

- 8. There are a lot of good cooks on the staff so our communal lunches are worth attending!
- 9. We're very near both the town centre shops and Bicester Village so the retail therapy is good if you want a change of scene.
