# Good Practice guideline re repeat prescribing when a patient temporarily moves into a nursing home

We recently received a query from a practice regarding responsibility for prescribing for patients when they move out of the practice area of their parent practice. Our LMC view is that the safety of and wellbeing of the patient is the priority here and medication errors occurring during transition pose a significant risk. On this basis, West Pennine LMC guidance is as follows:

- i) If the patient has moved from their own home for respite on a trial basis, the first monthly prescription should be issued by the original practice who will have an accurate and up to date list of medication, allergies, intolerances and current doses.
- ii) If the patient has moved from hospital or intermediate care, then the practice caring form them as a temporary resident should be responsible as they have the most up to date information.
