#### **MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 12 November 2013** 14/01/2

# 14/01/3 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

### 14/01/3.1 New Members of CLMC Limited

# 14/01/3.2 Attendees at LMC Conference 2014

Three places were allocated for CLMC at the LMC Conference which will take place on Thursday/Friday, 22/23 May 2014 in York. Normally the Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary attend but the Secretary will be attending in his GPDF capacity which leaves a vacancy. Dr McMahon had expressed an interest as had Dr G Chawla.

# 14/01/4 PROCUREMENT OF LOCAL SERVICES FROM PRACTICES wef 01.04.2014

### 14/01/4.1 Standard NHS Contract

A member raised concerns over all practices being given 3 months notice of termination, on 24 December 2013, for all enhanced services provided by practices and that as of 1 April 2014 practices will be faced with either doing the work for no payment or doing it under the NHS standard contract which was not designed to work within general practice i.e. it was not fit for purpose. Practices did not know what to do about staff who were employed under the current contract and will have to carry on with their employment until they know what is happening.

A lengthy discussion ensued. The LMC had been in discussions with CCGs and NECS concerning enhanced services since August 2013 and were frustrated that the termination notice had been issued on 24 December without any information as to what would be happening regarding going forward with enhanced services. The CCGs would be using the e-contract and have said they will remove sections that are not applicable. LES's come under CCGs and DES's under the Area Team. Once the e-contact is available the LMC Development Manager will go through it and flag up items for practices to look at.

H&S CCG Chief Officer said there were plans to run some sessions on the new contracting mechanism, particularly with Practice Managers, to give them an understanding of the contract. The CCG appreciates the contract is unwieldy. The process takes a long time because the CCG has to send things to the Area Team to safeguard conflict of interest towards GPs and this delays things; they are currently working with NHS England to get things put through. By the CCG working more closely with the LMC it is hoped that the quality of information can be improved for practices and issued quicker. Another letter with more information should be issued to all practices this week.

Public Health are now under the control of the Local Authorities, and the Local Authorities had no experience of issuing GP contracts and were learning how CLMC can assist them with enhanced

services. Public Health will be re-contracting the majority of services with practices though the mechanism had not yet been worked out. Initial discussions were about bundling and Public Health had been asked to bundle following the way practices work, looking at skill sets. Everyone should have had a standard Local Authority contract which was put in place last year; there was no change to that of which CLMC was aware, at the moment. It will take some time to work out the specifications but Public Health were asked to send the contract to practices / LMC as soon as possible. It was **AGREED** LMC would chase Public Health on this aspect.

### 14/01/4.2 Smoking Cessation

Concern was raised over the process by which Public Health were commissioning smoking cessation wef 1 April 2014. Practices had been notified that Public Health were not taking on any more patients up to 31 March 2014 because the patients would not have completed the treatment when the contract expired on 31 March 2014 and it was not known who would be taking over the running of the contract. The service specification on the LA website is lengthy, complex, very specific, public health orientated and lasts for two years only. The contract price for the whole of Tees is £303,000 + drugs. A success rate of 35% was expected after one year.

It was voiced that by the current provider of smoking cessation services not taking on any new patients, were Public Health terminating the contract? CLMC had challenged the Local Authority about this, without any resolution being reached. If any practices were interested in operating the service, the LMC Development Manager would be happy to look at the procurement information with them.

The Public Health Director said it was unfortunate what was happening but they had not been able to identify another provider. The tendering process is for a Local Authority LES and is separate from the Public Health LES which some practices are operating at the moment, which will continue. There was reassurance that the Local Authority will work with CLMC in future. Also, the Local Authority was used to re-tendering every 2 / max 3 years and they were being encouraged to amend this to 5 years for general practice.

The strong feeling in the room was that the Local Authority should not expect practices to pick up this extra smoking cessation work; practices were not contracted to do the work, it was not in the core contract and practices do not have the capacity. The Local Authority should sort it out.
