



Changes to adult blood tests (phlebotomy) services

We have made some changes to our adult blood test (phlebotomy) services.

You will now need to book an appointment before you come in for a blood test.

How can I book an appointment?

You can book, cancel, and amend blood test appointments online from Monday 6 December, 2021. The online booking system is easy to use, and you can choose to have your blood test at a date, time and location that is convenient for you.

If possible, please bring your blood form with you to the appointment, as we may not be able to print it for you

Will I still be able to have a walk-in appointment? Walk-in appointments are no longer available at any site. Please book ahead for a blood test appointment.

What about the blood test service for children? Children's blood tests are by appointment only. This has not changed.
