The Macmillan Information & Support Centre offers information & support to patients, their families and professionals on many aspects of living with cancer and its treatments. The drop-in centre provides guidance on practical issues of living with cancer and has close links with the clinical teams. We provide a range of support services including counselling, complementary therapies, welfare benefits advice, support groups, self management workshops and the hair loss clinic. The centre hosts a Macmillan Physical Activity Project to raise awareness of the benefits of physical activity for cancer patients and trained local exercise professionals in cancer rehabilitation. We would like this opportunity to promote awareness of the exercise referral schemes available to cancer patients in the locality.
