Although officially titled the Havant Support Group we welcome members from all surrounding areas including Hayling Island, Leigh Park and Emsworth. Most of our members are elderly, some have limited social contact outside their homes and the Group provides a lifeline for them. At our monthly meetings we invite speakers to give advice on current research, benefits, equipment and aids available. Some months we choose not to have a speaker and encourage our members to interact together and share their experiences.
