SEWSS is a not for profit organisation working in partnership with families, schools and other agencies to improve outcomes for children and young people. We use evidence-based parenting support to enable parents and carers to build on the strengths within their families and develop positive, healthy relationships. We currently provide the following family support services: Triple P (Primary, Teen and Stepping Stones programmes - groups and 1:2:1 support) Non-Violent Resistance Groups (for parents experiencing violent or controlling behaviour from their child) Speakeasy courses (helping parents discuss SRE issues with their Children's) Made of Money courses (helping families deal with the stress of living on a low income) CAF/Single Assessment completion service Online Safety Workshops.

WHO ARE OUR SERVICES FOR

Our service is available to parents/carers with children of all ages and on all tiers of need. We do not time-limit our services, and our only criteria for referral is parental consent.
