REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS

Requests for routine prescriptions may be made by registering for Patient Access (see website for details) by post, fax, or by calling at the surgery. We cannot accept telephone requests for prescriptions. Unless you are ordering online, requests for further supplies should be clearly made on the printout received each time you get a prescription. If you collect your prescription from the surgery, please allow two working days. If you go direct to the pharmacy to collect your medication, please allow three working days.

ELECTRONIC PRESCRIPTION SERVICE

A new system has been created to make it easier for you to pick up your repeat prescription. It is called the Electronic Prescription Service (EPS). With EPS you do not have to visit your practice to pick up your paper prescription. Your prescription can be sent electronically from the GP surgery to your nominated Pharmacy without the need for a paper copy. Please ask at Reception for further information.

FAMILY PLANNING

A family planning service is available by appointment during general surgeries by any of the doctors. Full family planning service available at Wycombe Hospital (Tel: 01494 425585 or 0300 303 2880).

DISABLED ACCESS

The surgery has wheelchair access via a ramp at the main entrance and cloakroom facilities suitable for wheelchairs.

PRACTICE BOUNDARY

NAMED GP

All our patients are allocated a named accountable GP who is responsible for your overall care at the practice. Please contact the practice if you want to know who this is. If you have a preference we will make reasonable efforts to accommodate this.

EMERGENCY OUT OF HOURS

In the first instance you should telephone the surgery and listen carefully to the recorded message. You will be given the appropriate telephone number to ring to connect you to the out-of-hours service.

Contact the 111 Service if you need help fast, but it is not a 999 emergency. This service can direct you to the GP out-of-hours service as well as provide information on doctors, community nurses, emergency dental care and late opening chemists. These calls are recorded. Calls from landlines and mobile phones are free—just like 999.

SPEAKING TO A DOCTOR OR NURSE

If you need to speak to a doctor or nurse during working hours, the receptionist will take a message for the doctor or nurse to ring you back.
