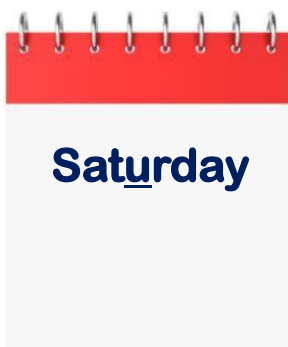

There are no steps outside the building.



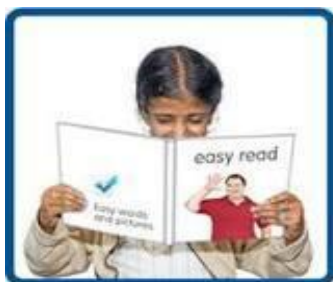
All our consulting rooms are on the ground floor.



There are accessible toilets.

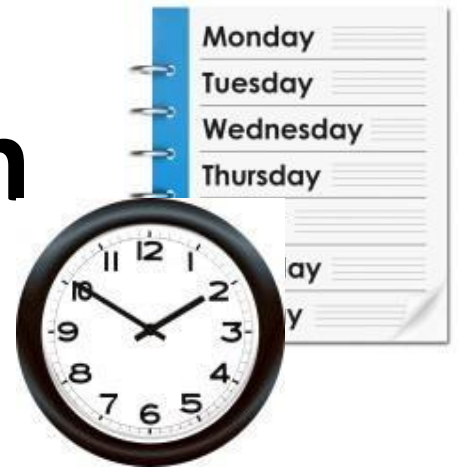


There is an induction loop in Reception.

How to make an Appointment



Phone 01452 543 000



The phone lines can get very busy. Phone after 10.30 am if it's not urgent. We are also very busy at 2pm.



Or come in to the surgery and ask for an appointment.



Ask to see your usual doctor if possible. This helps us get to know you better and give you better care.

New Patients



If you want to join this surgery you need to live in the local area.



Bring your medical card if you have one.



New patients will have a routine health check.



We will ask you to fill in a form with your medical details. We can help you fill it in.



Repeat Prescriptions

This means getting more of your usual medication without seeing a doctor.

How to get a repeat prescription



Hand in a Repeat Prescription form any day when we are open.

We have a post box on the wall so you don't have to queue.

We can help you fill in the form.

Sometimes the doctor or nurse will need to do a test to find out what is the matter with you.



Tests will be done in the surgery and then sent away.

It takes up to 7 days for most test results to come back to the surgery. Please ask the person who takes the test how long the results will take.

Or you can phone the surgery for your results. Please call after 9.30 in the morning and after 3.30 in the afternoon.
