



FP92A Common Pitfalls

Diabetes Mellitus is the common form of diabetes that most people will have heard of.

Diabetes insipidus is an unrelated and much rarer condition.

Hypoparathyroidism is not treated with thyroxine/ levothyroxine.

Myxoedema is a synonymous term for hypothyroidism. This is the condition most often treated with thyroxine/ levothyroxine.

Being eligible for DLA/ PIP care component can be used as evidence that a person has “a continuing physical disability which means [that person] cannot go out without the help of another person” unless the reason for that eligibility is for a mental illness.

Other medical condition exemptions are self-explanatory. If you are unsure: ask.
