Diabetes	Mellitus	is t	he	common	form	of	diabetes	that	most	people	will	have	heard

Diabetes insipidus is an unrelated and much rarer condition.

Hypoparathyroidism is not treated with thyroxine/ levothyroxine.

Myxoedema is a synonymous term for hypothyroidism. This is the condition most often treated with thyroxine/ levothyroxine.

Being eligible for DLA/ PIP care component can be used as evidence that a person has "a continuing physical disability which means [that person] cannot go out without the help of another person" unless the reason for that eligibility is for a mental illness.

Other medical condition exemptions are self-explanatory. If you are unsure: ask.
