Going to university in the autumn?

If you move away from home to go to university, it is usual for you to register with a new surgery, close to your new address which means that you will be taken off our list.

Often registration is completed as part of the university induction process and we have had occasions when students returning home in the holidays were not aware they had registered with a new surgery at university.

We recommend that you register with a GP at the address you are living **most** of the time, which is likely to be your university address.

However, this does mean that you will no longer be registered with Bridge Surgery and, unless you live within Stapenhill and Brizlincote, we will not be able to see you as a temporary patient in the university holidays.

If you do not live in Stapenhill or Brizlincote (e.g. Winshill, Branston, Horninglow, Stretton, Rolleston etc.) and wish to be seen in the university holidays, you will be advised to contact the surgery nearest to your address to arrange to be seen as a temporary patient.

After you have completed your university course if you return to your previous home address we will not be able to re-register you as a permanent patient unless you live in Stapenhill or Brizlincote, our inner catchment area.
