Shingles Vaccination

Invitations to newly eligible patients (i.e. those born on or after 02/09/46 and aged 70 years) are being sent out in batches commencing July 2017.

Hepatitis A Travel Vaccination

Unfortunately there is a worldwide shortage of Hepatitis A vaccinations and we do not have any stock at the present time. We have been advised supplies may not be available until 2018.

Hepatitis B Travel Vaccination

Unfortunately this vaccine is not available on the NHS for travel purposes. We can offer this privately and the course consists of three injections and costs £90.00. This is payable at reception before your first injection is given.

Meningococcal (Men) ACWY Vaccination

Invitations to teenagers born between 01/09/1998 - 31/08/1999 are being sent out in batches commencing July 2017.
