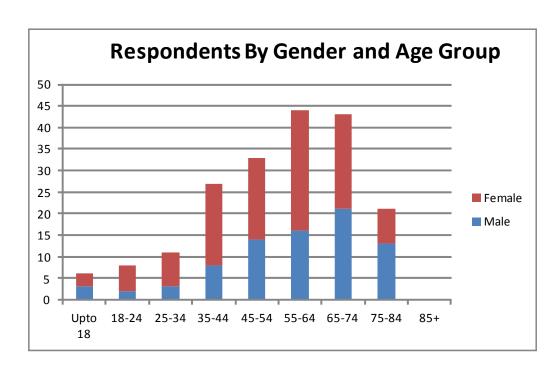

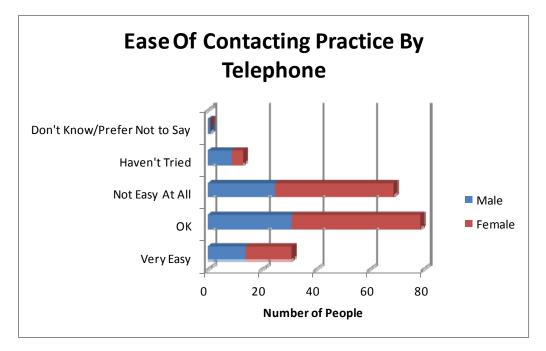

Overall % of people satisfied with ability to make contact by telephone

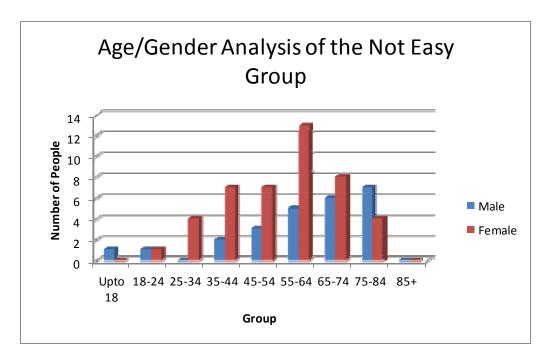

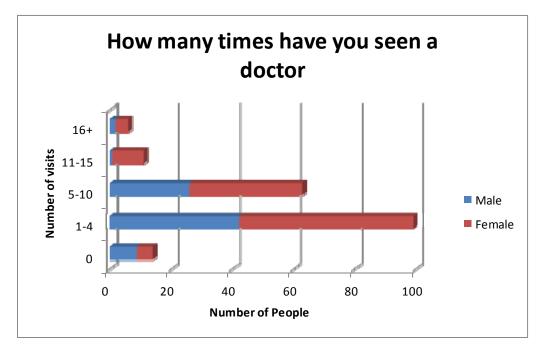

Overall % of people satisfied with convenience

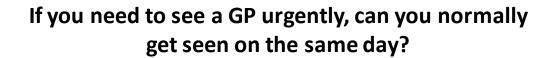

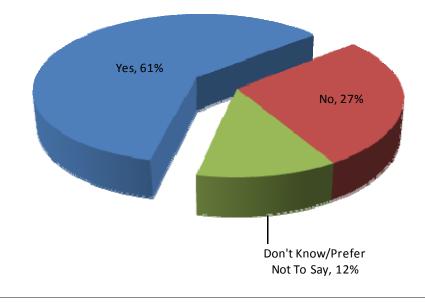

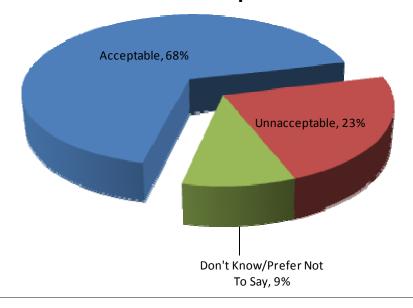


- If you need to see a doctor in an emergency you can ask to be seen by the duty doctor.
- Duty doctor appointments are for emergencies for example, sudden onset symptoms such as chest pain, difficulty in breathing etc or lumps or unexplained bleeding

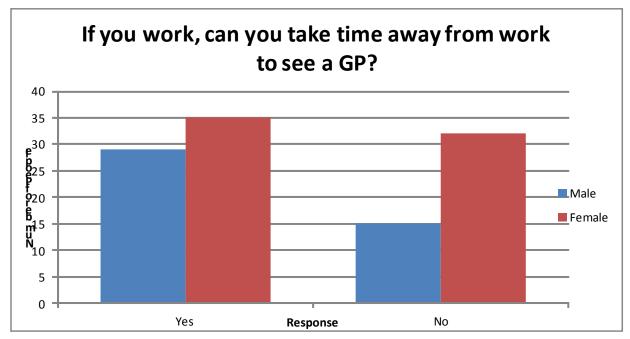
Remember
