### 4. Important Changes to Choose and Book Scheduled for June 2015

The NHS e-Referral service, the successor to Choose and Book, will be available from Monday 15th June 2015.

All past and current referrals made on Choose and Book will have been safely and securely migrated and will be available on the new service from day one. The NHS e-Referral Service will be functionally equivalent to Choose and Book meaning little or no training will be required for users. The transition should not cause any disruption to patient care or working practices and users will be able to utilise the new service to support patients from day one. Read more...
