Online Services

Please sign up for our online services, bring some photographic identification, plus proof of address into reception and we will set you up with a password and then you will be able to order repeat prescriptions, book and cancel appointments and request to view your medical record. Prescription requests via email are now not available.

When you ring the surgery please stay on the line. There are up to 10 staff answering the phone at busy times so you should get through in a short time, if you hang up you will go to the back of the queue!!

Controlled Drugs

Controlled drug prescriptions can now go through electronically to the Pharmacy.

Please go into the Pharmacy of your choice and sign up with them if you have not already done so.

If you are already signed up to a Pharmacy, then all your medications will be able to be processed electronically.

Please ask at Reception for more informationor if you have other items which could now go electronically.

Ear Syringing

After recent discussion with the GP Partners, it has been decided that although we will continue offering appointments for ear syringing, we will be stricter on our procedure for booking in. Patients will need to have been seen either by a Nurse, Health Care Assistant or GP in order for them to have their ears syringed by Carol, Nurse who provides this service.

Patients should have been using either Olive Oil or Sodium Bicarbonate ear drops for a minimum of 14 days prior to ear syringing.

With effect from Monday 20th May there will be a dedicated EAR SYRINGING session every Monday afternoon, running from between 3-6pm. If you are unable to attend on a Monday you can book into one of the other community ear clinics such as at Bath Street, Warrington, (Monday & Thursday afternoons) 01925 843853, Penketh Clinic, Tuesday afternoon) 01925 867930, and Orford Jubilee Park (Wednesday afternoon) 01925 572504.


Patients who Do Not Attend (DNA) Appointments
