Wart Clinic

HCA

Why not book in with our HCA for a blood pressure, pulse and weight check

Named GP for every patient

We are in the process of allocating every patient to a named GP – this is a contractually requirement. You do not need to do anything as this is done automatically. You can still see any of the GPs at the surgery regardless of who you are registered to.

Prostate Awareness

The prostate is a gland that lies beneath the bladder and is usually the size of a chestnut.

As men get older it increases in size and can cause the following symptoms:

- Reduced urine flow
- Dribbling afterwards
- Having to rush to the toilet frequently or urgently
- Difficulty starting urination
- Getting up frequently at night to urinate
- A stream that starts and stops.

In the vast majority of people these symptoms will be a sign of benign prostatic hypertrophy (BPH) but a blood test (PSA) and examination of the prostate can help to exclude prostate cancer.
