Flu/Shingles Vaccinations

Flu Vaccination Clinics are running throughout the day and also between 6:30 and 8pm on a Wednesday night. We are not sending out any written invitations –if you are not sure if you are eligible please ask at reception. If you are not entitled to a Flu Vaccine on the NHS the local chemists can arrange this privately.

Shingles vaccine is available for patients who are aged 70, 78 and 79 years on 1 September 2014

Surgery Development

Plans are in the final stages of approval to convert and renovate the rooms adjacent to the large waiting area into additional consultation rooms. Work should begin early in the new year.
