The Practice is a designated training practice which involves training doctors and medical students. We currently have:

2 Registrar (ST3) and 1 FY1/2

We also take Medical Students and Student Nurses.

We are open to all patients living within our practice boundary in Darwen and the surrounding areas. We work in partnership with our patient's and our Patient Participation Group to provide a high standard of medical care for our patients.

We are a General Medical Service (GMS) Practice offering Primary care services for the diagnosis and prevention of disease. We help patients to manage their health and prevent illness. Our GPs assess, diagnose, treat and manage illness. They carry out screening for some diseases and promote general health and wellbeing.

Our GPs act as a patient's advocate, supporting and representing a patient's best interest to ensure they receive the best and most appropriate health and/or social care. Our GPs also work closely with other healthcare colleagues and can provide a link to further health services.

Our GPs also arrange hospital admissions and referrals to other services and specialists and they link in with secondary and community services regarding patient care, take advice when needed and sharing information on a need to know basis. Our GPs also collect and record important information received from other healthcare professionals involved in the treatment of our patients.
