Pneumococcal Vaccinations

If you are 65 or over you will be offered a type of pneumo jab known as the pneumococcal polysaccharide vaccine (PPV), This one off vaccination is very effective at protecting you against serious forms of pneumococcal infection. Whooping Cough Vaccination in Pregnancy

Pregnant women can safely protect their babies by getting vaccinated- ideally 28-32 weeks Pregnant although they may be given the vaccine up to 38 weeks of pregnancy. The NHS Friends and Family Test (FFT) was launched in December 2014, giving an important opportunity for you to provide feedback on the care and treatment you receive and to improve services. IF YOU DON'T NEED IT - CANCEL IT!!

Due to the number of people who fail to attend appointments at the surgery we have a strict Did Not Attend Policy now in operation.

During the month of June 43 Patients failed to attend pre-bookable appointments with their usual GP and 5 Patients failed to attend an on the day emergency appointment.

During the month of July 63 Patients failed to attend pre-bookable appointments with their usual GP and 13 Patients failed to attend an on the day emergency appointment.

If you are unable to keep an appointment at the surgery please remember to cancel it. If we have your up to date mobile number you will receive a text reminder and have the option to text back CANCEL if not required.

If you fail to attend 2 appointments in a 6 month period we will write to you to bring this to your attention. A further missed appointment will again generate a letter. Following that if we need to write to you again you may be removed from the practice list and have to find an alternative GP.
