What we are trying to achieve

Our aim is to undertake a reconfiguration and modernisation of the surgery to:

- Improve patient services.
- Create a better patient environment.
- Create a better and safer entrance to the building from the car park area.
- Provide a larger reception and waiting area to allow for social distancing and to meet infection control standards.
- Open up the first floor of the surgery to all patients, meeting current disabled access standards.
- Future proof the building to provide high quality care for our patients for many years to come.

The Proposals

The works will provide the following:

- A new glass extension to the surgery off the car park elevation of the building, providing direct access to the ground floor and the introduction of a new staircase and disabled access lift to the first floor.
- Reconfiguration of the existing surgery to provide a new, more accessible and visually prominent reception from both entrances to the building.
- The creation of a larger patient waiting area at ground floor and the introduction of a better waiting area at first floor.
- The internal reconfiguration of the surgery will also allow for an increase in the number of clinical rooms.





How you can help

During the building works, surgery opening hours and services will remain unchanged.

However, the building site compound will take up an area of the surgery car park and we request that you refrain from using the car park if at all possible whilst the compound is in place to leave sufficient parking spaces for those that are unable to walk to the surgery.

At all times, please take care when using the car park whilst the building site is operational.

For your own safety, please follow the signage provided around the exterior of the building and inside the surgery.
