PRIVATE AND PROFESSIONAL FEES FROM OCTOBER 2023

Some services you may require are not covered by the National Health Service and a charge will be levied for those as recommended by the British Medical Association. They include BUPA and other private insurance forms, private medical certificates, and examinations for sports, education, driving, or employment.

We accept payment by cash, debit card or credit card. A list of fees is displayed below:

Statement of fitness for school/sport/specific employment	£30.00
Freedom from infection certificate	£30.00
Confirmation of identity (passport countersignature, etc)	£30.00
Character reference (job, etc)	£30.00
Completion of certificate for private health insurance	£30.00
Firearms certificate	£50.00
Power of Attorney (signature only)	£50.00
Power of Attorney (examination)	£150.00
Jury Duty Exemption Certificate	No charge

REPORTS (without examination)

Report on proforma eg Army / Navy / RAF etc	Fee as per invoice
DVLA	£100.00
Legal purposes (accident / employment etc)	£100.00-£200.00 (time based, may need payment in advance)

REPORT (with examination)

Camp America/JET (20 min GP)	£100.00
University of New Hampshire – 20 min GP, 15 min Nurse	£180 (GP/Nurse time + private bloods)
Private/Employment/Insurance (30 min appt)	£150
(e.g. HGV, LGV, PCV, taxi driver, elderly driver, certain fitness certificates)	

TRAVEL ABROAD

Fitness to travel certificate	£30.00
Holiday cancellation (confirmation on medical grounds)	£50.00

OVERSEAS VISITORS

Although there is no fee for immediately necessary consultations with a GP or Practice Nurse, a fee may apply for items not covered by the NHS under General Medical Services.

Private consultation (15 mins Nurse, 20 mins GP)	£40 Nurse, £100 GP
Private GP home visit	£160

Please note: Charges for these services may vary as different organisations may have different requirements
